LOCATION: The 45 full time employees operate out of the City Operations Center, Motor Pool, Patton Park Building, and Sugarloaf Warehouse. In addition, you'll see their workers all over town: parks, greenways, streets, traffic signals, etc.

ADMINISTRATION: Tom Wooten, Director, Chad Freeman, Assistant Director, Tammy Ledford, Admin Assistant III, and Brianna Wilson, Admin Assistant I. The mini-golf employees are hired seasonally.

TRAFFIC - Brandon Mundy, supervisor. This division maintains city traffic signals (not NCDOT signals) & city owned street lights (not Duke Energy lights), all signage on city streets, pavement markings, parking kiosks, and controllers. Employees - Brent Pope

ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICE - Josh Hoard, supervisor. This division operates a five-day schedule to pick up garbage, brush and recycling throughout the City and helps to clean Main Street. BUILDING MAINTENANCE - Larry Reeves, supervisor. These employees maintain all City facilities including buildings, parks equipment, playgrounds and Patton Pool. Additionally they handle construction, mechanical, electrical and plumbing needs. Employees - Ross Henderson, Deon Mendosa, Terry Smith

STREETS - Timmy Hensley, supervisor. This division maintains 65 miles of City streets, not NCDOT streets, thru resurfacing, repairs, fixing potholes, sweeping and snow removal. FLEET - Larry Mundy, supervisor. This divisions maintains and services over 400 items of City equipment and vehicles. They also fabricate through welding and metal work items for the City. Employees - AJ Bonhan, Alex Martin, Jesse Anders, Patrick Warren, Sean Schofield

GROUNDS - Kevin Rhodes, supervisor. Maintains 14 parks, downtown and the Greenway through mowing, watering, planting, repair and maintenance; mows traffic islands, runs side arm mower along right of ways, waters hanging baskets, and helps clean Main Street; cares for Oakdale Cemetery and, seasonally, responsible for leaf collection and snow & ice removal.
