Local Non-profits

Big Brothers & Big Sisters* - Matching mentors with children facing adversity.

Blue Ridge Humane Society* - Adoption, outreach, and education to help animals.

Boys and Girls Club of Henderson County* - Provides year-round activities and programs to meet the interests of youth.

Children and Family Resource Center* - Helping children dealing with poverty, child abuse and neglect, teen pregnancy, affordable childcare, behavioral issues and developmental delays.

Council on Aging* - Caring for the elderly of our community thru caregiver services, Meals on Wheels, and more.

Crossnore School – Providing homes for children in foster care (both in community homes and on residential campuses).

The Free Clinics - Free care to low-income, uninsured residents of Henderson and Polk Counties.

Guardian Ad Litem - Trained volunteers paired with an attorney to advocate for the best interests of a child.

Hendersonville Housing Assistance - Providing safe and affordable housing for persons of limited income.

IAM - Interfaith Assistance Ministry – Assisting with basic needs such as food, clothing, heat/utilities, rent, medications, school supplies, unusual Hardships or medical-related unusual hardships.

MountainTrue – Works for the good of natural systems – air, land, water, and native plants and animals,.

Pisgah Legal Services* - Provides free civil legal aid to vulnerable people.

St. Gerard House – Treatment for individuals with Autism and other behavioral health needs and their caregivers.

Safelight* - Provides support for survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault and child abuse. in crisis.

Thrive* - Assisting individuals who are experiencing mental health and housing instability get back on their feet.

True Ridge – Works to connect members of the Latinx community with the resources and opportunities.

United Way - Through donations, gives funds to worthy non-profits in Henderson County.

Western Carolina Community Action (WCCA) - Assists low income and underserved people through advocacy and quality services such as Head Start, housing programs, transportation, programs for older adults and more.
